**Charity Bowl for November & December  
The Greenwich & Bexley Hospice**

Every year they care for over 2,500 people, at home, in care homes, in hospice beds, day hospice and in hospital, but receive only around a third of funding from the NHS. This means they need to fundraise £5m every year from local people, businesses and organisations. The Hospice was co-founded by Pat Jeavons and Don Sturrock in 1985, and now has 19 inpatient beds caring for over 350 people each year.
